

INTERMEDIATE - SPILL RESPONSE TRAINING

- Course suited to individuals who may act as first responders to a spillage incident.
- The training meets all Environmental Agency, DEFRA and ISO14001 requirements and shows the impact a spill can have on the local environment and water courses.
- The course takes approximately 2/2.5 hours - a break will be provided.
- A two-part Power-point presentation will be given on providing an improved level of response to emergency spills, thereby helping to reduce corporate financial exposure to risks of polluting the environment.
- To improve the knowledge and understanding of the physical dangers of spillage, typical routes of escape from the site and how to use containment and absorbent products to effectively control a spill.
- To create awareness of individuals' moral and legal responsibilities for causing pollution within the water environment.
- A practical 'dry' demonstration is carried out using the trainers spill kit to show the attendees what is typically contained in the spill kit or absorbent station and which order to use the components with a spill.

Emphasis is placed on the three golden rules

1. Identify the product spilled and select appropriate PPE or help
2. Secure the entire spill area to reduce the risk of slip accidents
3. Cover any vulnerable drains as a priority

Training Stipulations

- Each course can accommodate up to 12 people maximum (all delegates to provide their own standard PPE)
- Certificates will be produced from attendance list signed on the day by delegates, training manuals provided
- 2 courses can be run in one day
- Site requirements, inside room made available with table and chairs, on-site TV link for trainers' computer and safe space made available in yard for practical demonstration, either indoors or outdoors weather permitting

Depending on the location and number of courses booked, accommodation and travel expenses may be added to the total cost on a POA basis. Late cancellations (within 7 days of training date) will incur a charge of up to 100% of the total cost of any training course/courses booked.
