

## BASIC SPILL KIT TRAINING COURSE

- A safety-first course on the use of spill kits and absorbent stations.
- The training meets all Environmental Agency, DEFRA and ISO14001 requirements and shows the impact a spill can have on the local environment and water courses.
- The course will take approximately 1 hour.
- A short Power-point presentation will be provided on; know your absorbents for correct use, products, containment, step by step spill practice & response, handling a spill for material application, legislation and your company commitment to spills.
- A practical 'dry' demonstration is carried out using the trainers spill kit. This shows the attendees what is typically contained in the spill kit or absorbent station, and which order to use each component.

### Emphasis is placed on the three golden rules

1. Identify the product spilled and select appropriate PPE or help
2. Secure the entire spill area to reduce the risk of slip accidents
3. Cover any vulnerable drains as a priority

### Theory

- Basic spill actions and safety rules

### Practical

- Attendees perform a 'dry' demo following the discussed theory
- Training Stipulations
- Each course can accommodate up to 15 people maximum (all delegates to provide their own standard PPE)
- Certificates will be produced from attendance list signed on the day by delegates, training manuals provided
- Six courses can be run in one day
- Site requirements, inside room made available with table and chairs, on-site TV link for trainers computer and safe space made available in yard for practical demonetisation, either indoors or outdoors weather permitting

Depending on the location and amount of courses booked, accommodation and travel expenses may be added to the total cost on a POA basis. Late cancellations (within 7 days of training date) will incur a charge of up to 100% of the total cost of any training course/courses booked.
